Featuring Cape Cod Commission Presentation:
“Planning to Keep Wellfleet Special”**

The 2018 Annual Meeting of the membership of the Wellfleet Conservation Trust will be held on Saturday, August 18, and is open to the public. The doors open at 9:30 AM for morning refreshments and informal discussions. The business meeting will convene at 10 AM and will include the nomination and election of individuals to the Board of Trustees, a financial report, and an activity report. Following the business section, **Ms. Heather McElroy** of the Cape Cod Commission will present "**Planning to Keep Wellfleet Special.**" The meeting will take place at the Wellfleet Council on Aging building at 715 Old King's Highway in Wellfleet.

Ms. McElroy is the Natural Resources/Land Specialist at the Cape Cod Commission (CCC). The CCC is the Regional Planning Authority for Cape Cod established by the Massachusetts Legislature to oversee and guide the Towns of Cape Cod in their planning and development. In her address, she will cover how the CCC works with the Cape towns; describe recent initiatives such as the NOAA funded grant called Resilient Cape Cod; and the technical services provided to Wellfleet for zoning and Conservation Commission efforts.
